This letter is the final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), dated October 2, 2017. You have requested copies of the following records:

All communications between the Presidential Advisory Commission on Election Integrity (“Commission”) and/or its Chair and/or the White House and ICE concerning the transfer of personal data from the agency to the Commission.

ICE has conducted a search of the ICE’s Office of Principal Legal Advisor (OPLA) and the Director’s Office for records responsive to your request and no records responsive to your request were found.

For your information, Congress excluded three discrete categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIA. See 5 U.S.C. § 552(c) (2006 & Supp. IV (2010)). This response is limited to those records that are subject to the requirements of the FOIA. This is a standard notification that is given to all our requesters and should not be taken as an indication that excluded records do, or do not, exist.
