Pursuant to the proposed court order, filed on November 22, 2019, we have reprocessed 16 documents, totaling 94 pages, previously withheld in full.

For this production, DHS reviewed 94 pages. We have determined to release four pages in full. Further, DHS has determined to withhold in part four pages, pursuant to FOIA Exemptions (b)(5), (b)(6), and (b)(7)(E). We are withholding in full 80 pages pursuant to FOIA Exemptions (b)(5), (b)(6), and (b)(7)(E). Finally, six pages require further consultation with another Agency. We will notify you when these records are returned to our office.
