Dear Mr. Davisson:

This is our sixth interim response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), dated September 9, 2016.

For this production, DHS reviewed 359 pages of which 77 pages are withheld in full pursuant to FOIA exemption (b)(5) and two pages are withheld in part pursuant to FOIA exemption (b)(6). 221 pages were duplicates or non-responsive. DHS has also located and sent 19 pages to other agencies for consultation and sent 40 pages to the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) for review and direct response. The 79 pages for release are bates stamped DHS-001-0545-000264 to DHS-001-0545-000342.
