This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request.

Based on the information you provided, we conducted a search of the Central Records System. We are unable to fulfill your request for the updated Facial Recognition Technology Privacy Threshold Analysis (PTA) and Privacy Impact Assessment (PIA) at this time, as both documents are currently being drafted. Until these documents are finalized, they will not be available to the public.

It is unnecessary to adjudicate your fee waiver because no responsive main file records were processed.
