3.4 Optional Capabilities

3.4.1 Automated Threat Detection Marking

The AIT system *shall* (193) provide an automated detection highlighting function in meeting detection requirements.

Automated detection highlighting of anomalies shall (194) be coded red.

Automated detection highlighting shall (195) be bounded by a box indicating the location of the anomaly.

The AIT system shall (196) provide a means for the IO to toggle automated detection highlighting on and off.
