**10. NARRATIVE**

On July 18, 2018, the OPR Fairfax office received information from (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) alleging an unknown individual was impersonating an ICE officer.

According to (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) On July 18, 2018, at approximately 1:00 P.M., the Metropolitan Police Department of the District of Columbia (MPD) received information that an unknown individual wearing an "ICE" shirt, and in possession of a firearm, was seen in the vicinity of the American University. (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) said the MPD and the U.S. Secret Service were attempting to locate the individual.

That same day, at approximately 5:45 P.M., MPD requested assistance from HSI in identifying the subject using facial recognition. MPD provided photographs to HSI and stated the subject was wearing black BDU pants, a black shirt with the words "ICE" and "police" on it, and a black hat with the word "ice" written on some tape.


At approximately 6:30 P.M. HSI determined facial recognition would not be possible due to the poor image quality of the photographs provided by MPD.

On August 6, 2018, ICE OPR Senior Special Agent (SSA) (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) Fairfax, Virginia, obtained the MPD incident report number (b)(6); (b)(7)(C)

A review of the report disclosed that, on July 18, 2018, MPD officers responded to a report of a (b)(6); (b)(7)(C)

(b)(6); (b)(7)(C) A witness stated the male was wearing black BDUs and a black shirt with the words "ICE" and "police" on it, as well as a black hat with the word "ice" written on tape affixed to the hat. Additionally, the witness stated the male was wearing a black gun belt with a revolver in a brown holster. According to the report, MPD officers reviewed closed circuit video footage and were unable to verify if the suspicious male was armed.

At this time there is no identifiable or clearly articulated employee misconduct. Pending the receipt of any additional actionable information related to employee misconduct, this investigation is closed and does not require any agency action.
