Pursuant to the settlement agreement executed on March 28, 2022 for the above matter, EOUSA is providing you with a chart including the numerical breakdown by district of the total number of applications, search warrants, and orders during the processing of potentially responsive records in this matter.

Please note, that upon completing the numerical breakdown, EOUSA realized that there was an error concerning the number of pages withheld in the third interim response, which included the records processed for the District of Rhode Island. The interim response stated 182 pages were withheld in full, and the total is 188 pages, as outlined in the attached chart.
