Dear Ms. Kyriakides:

This is a supplemental release of records to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), received on March 31, 2017.

In an effort to further narrow the issues in dispute, DHS agreed to conduct a review the records remaining at issue to reevaluate opportunities to reveal any additional portions of the documents redacted in full and to determine if, in DHS's discretion, any additional disclosures could be made. DHS agreed to review the records and make additional releases by today, August 17, 2020.

Pursuant to this agreement, we have reviewed 12 documents, totaling 72 pages, previously withheld in full.

We have determined to release 20 pages in full. Further, DHS has determined to withhold in part 50 pages, pursuant to FOIA Exemptions (b)(5), (b)(6), and (b)(7)(E). Finally, we are withholding in full two pages pursuant to FOIA Exemptions (b)(5), (b)(6), and (b)(7)(E).
