Dear Mr. Davisson and Ms. Zhou:

Per your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated September 11, 2019—assigned processing number EPIC-2019-001—the National Security Commission on Artificial Intelligence (NSCAI) is providing you with the attached seventh production.

During the month of July, NSCAI reviewed 131 records—comprising 819 pages. 79 records—comprising 310 pages—were determined to be not responsive to your FOIA request. 38 additional records—comprising 347 pages—were identified as duplicates and removed from processing. 2 records—comprising 24 pages—have been referred to other government agencies for response directly to you.

For this seventh production, NSCAI is producing today 11 records—comprising 88 pages—responsive to your request that consist of materials that were provided to the full Commission. The records in this production include remaining agendas and summaries of conclusions associated with the Commission’s working groups as well as presentations or other materials provided to staff by outside parties and shared with all 15 Commissioners. Please see the attached Vaughn Index for information about the redactions in the records produced to you today, including 1 record—comprising 50 pages—NSCAI is withholding in full under applicable FOIA exemptions.

NSCAI will continue to process the records identified to date and other records potentially responsive to your FOIA request.
