To follow-up, in FY19 the JAIC got \$89M reprogrammed and currently has:

32 Civ (GS) - 10 are permanent positions

29 Mil - 8 are permanent positions

46 Civ (contractors)

Total: 107

In FY20, the current HAC-D mark-up has them getting \$224M (\$270M was the Presidential Budget request) and provides for:

16 permanent mil positions

62 permanent civilian (GS) positions (including 1x SES)

They anticipate real growth over the current 107 through continued details and contractors, but can't project those numbers with precision.
