Upon consideration of Defendants' Motion to Dismiss FACA Claims, Plaintiff's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment, the oppositions and replies thereto, and the entire record before this Court, it is hereby

ORDERED that Defendants' Motion to Dismiss FACA Claims is **DENIED**;

ORDERED Plaintiff's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment is **GRANTED**;

ORDERED that Defendants shall provide timely notice in the Federal Register of any future meetings of the National Security Commission on Artificial Intelligence, consistent with 5 U.S.C. app. 2 § 10(a)(2);

ORDERED that Defendants shall permit members of the public to attend any future meetings of the National Security Commission on Artificial Intelligence, consistent with 5 U.S.C. app. 2 § 10(a)(3); and

ORDERED that Defendants shall immediately make available for public inspection and copying the records, reports, transcripts, minutes, appendixes, working papers, drafts, studies,

agenda, or other documents which were made available to or prepared for or by the National Security Commission on Artificial Intelligence, consistent with 5 U.S.C. app. 2 § 10(b).
