Pursuant to the notice published November 8, 2017 (“Policy Regarding Live Audio Streaming of Arguments”), I write on behalf of the Electronic Privacy Information Center (EPIC) to request live audio streaming of arguments in *EPIC v. Presidential Advisory Commission on Election Integrity*, No. 17-5171 (D.C. Cir. docketed July 27, 2017). Arguments are scheduled for next Tuesday, November 21 at 9:30 a.m. in Courtroom 31 before Judges Henderson, Williams, and Ginsburg.

EPIC v. Commission uniquely implicates the privacy rights of voters across the country. Voters should have the opportunity to learn more about the proceedings in this case, the issues presented to the Court, and the Court’s consideration of the matter. If there are factual circumstances that provide a basis to offer live streaming, *EPIC v. Commission* clearly presents those circumstances.
