This is in response to your January 15, 2004 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request. We received your request in our Office on January 27, 2004.

A search within the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA) yielded the enclosed document as responsive to your request. These two pages are from John Poindexter's (former Director, Information Awareness Office) appointment calendar. There was no subject matter given, therefore we do not know what was discussed.

Ms. Jan Walker, Special Assistant of External Relations, an Initial Denial Authority, has denied a portion of the enclosed document pursuant to 5 USC § 552 (b)(6), information that would clearly constitute an unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of individuals.

You may appeal Ms. Walker's decision to deny the information by offering justification to support an additional release. Any such appeal should be sent to this Office, cite our FOIA case number 04-F-0657, and be postmarked within 60 calendar days of the date of this letter. There are no assessable fees in this instance.
